ABOUT SWITCHBACK ORGANIC VINEYARD

Switchback Organic Vineyard, established in 2006, is a ten-acre site located on a bench looking across Okanagan Lake to the Naramata Bench. Switchback has a long farming history: parts of the original irrigation flume that carried water to the area farms can still be found at the top of our site.

In 2020, we changed certification and are now part of ECOCERT, an organic certification organization, founded in France in 1991. It is based in Europe but conducts inspections in over 80 countries, making it one of the largest organic certification organizations in the world. ECOCERT's co-founder and CEO is William Vidal.
